INFORMATION FOR ARTISTS AND CRAFTSPERSONS

The Gallery in the Butteville Store, the oldest operating store in Oregon, is seeking artists and craftspersons to consign art that is interpretive of the area—the French Prairie region, Butteville, Champoeg, the Willamette River, and the State of Oregon. The Store is operated by the non-profit group, the Friends of Historic Champoeg. Art and craft items will be sold on a consignment basis. Items may depict early or current lifestyle. Items selected for display and sale may relate to area history, flora, fauna, geology and geography, pioneer crafts or Native American culture.

All accepted gallery artists and all sellers of consigned items must join or be a member of The Friends of Historic Champoeg. (\$20.00)

The Store will be open from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Items for sale must be delivered to the Store prior to Memorial Day and not removed until after Labor Day, unless replaced with another approved item with arrangements made for the transfer in advance. The Store will be open Thursdays through Sundays and Holidays.

The Gallery will take 40% commission and pricing of work is to be decided by the artist. All efforts will be made to avoid duplication of work.

Artists will be responsible for delivery and pick up of items and the preparation of the consignment list of work dropped off.
